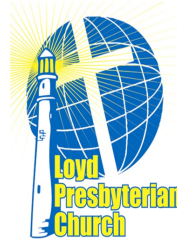

What is a meal train?

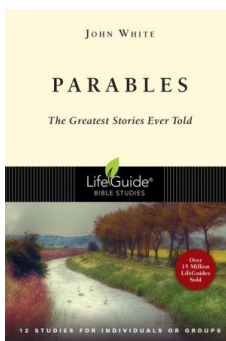
When a friend is in need, everyone asks "What can I do to help?" The answer is always to provide support through a meal. When many friends provide support through a meal, this is a Meal Train.

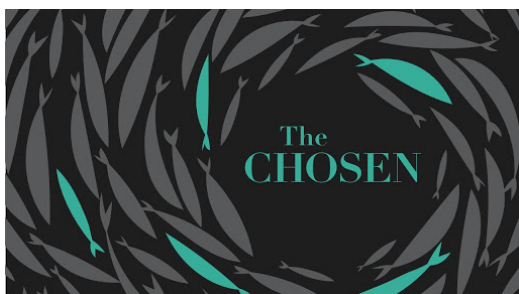
