A Message from Tyler:

On Sunday, Feb 19th, we will be celebrating Transfiguration Sunday. The story of Jesus being transfigured, shining like the sun, and communing with Moses and Elijah is probably one that we all know quite well. This passage is the one that precedes Lent, where we begin liturgically marching toward the cross event and the resurrection. Jesus is shown to the disciples who join him, Peter, James, and John, as the Son of Man.

Ronald J. Allen, Professor Emeritus at Christian Theological Seminary, refers to the outcome of this event as being "present in the old age but shining with the light of the new." Jesus still exists in the world of Old Testament Law and the Roman Empire. Yet, the story tells us about a transformation in which he foretells a new existence, forgiven by the grace of God and free of the Romans.

May we also be present in the old age while shining with the light of the new. May it be so for each of us individually, as the church, and to the world.

Calling all Youth! Please join us for a kick-off event this Sunday, February 19 at 12:00 in the Youth basement.


