

A Message from Tyler:

A few years ago, I was asked by Destiny Williams of McDonough Presbyterian Church to serve as a chaperone for Triennium. The theme of the conference was, "Go!" With just a single word, the planners had captured a powerful question that we sometimes ponder as faithful Christians: "What do I do when God tells me to go?" I have a fond memory of getting to ride a bike down the center aisle at St. Luke's Presbyterian Church as a way to advertise Triennium to those gathered for a Presbytery meeting.


A Youth Update:


