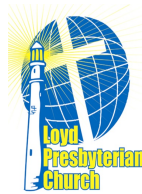

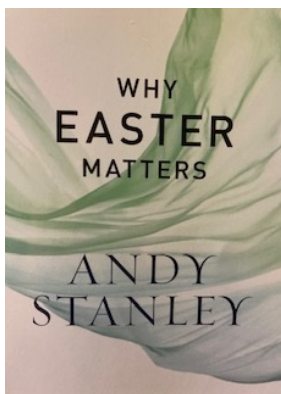
A Youth Update:

A Core 13 Update:



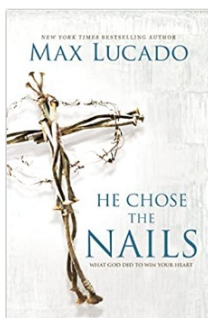
Core 13 is currently studying "Why Easter Matters" by Andy Stanley.

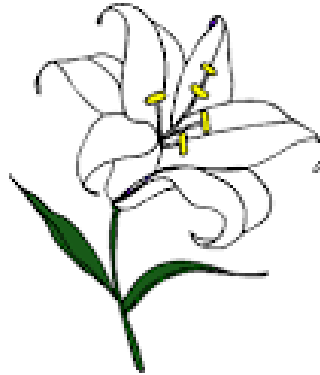
