A Message from Tyler:

After a long Lenten season, we celebrate Jesus's triumphant entrance into the city of Jerusalem riding on a donkey. This story marks the beginning of the Easter narrative. It also represents a fulfillment of the Zechariah scripture that states the "the king is coming to you, humble and mounted on a donkey." Lent is not yet over, but it is coming to a close.

Dr. Keith Wagner wrote in a sermon that we easily recognize societal symbols. The US flag represents freedom and sacrifice. If we see the "golden arches," we know that we are looking at McDonald's. At Christmas, we have Santa and at Easter, we have a bunny.

Jesus's entrance as a king on a donkey riding into Jerusalem is reminiscent of David's entrance to the city with the ark. For the people of David's time, this was a symbol of God and God's people moving from the wilderness to the permanent city and temple. For the people of Jesus's time, they recognize the symbol of Jesus as the Messiah and Davidic king coming to the Roman ruled Israelites. We move one step closer to the resurrection and Eastertide.

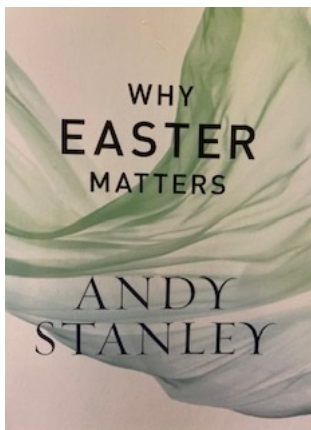

Core 13 is currently studying "Why Easter Matters" by Andy Stanley.

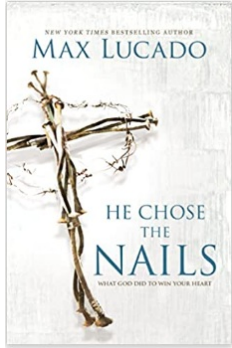
This series investigates the people who found their way into the story of Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection.

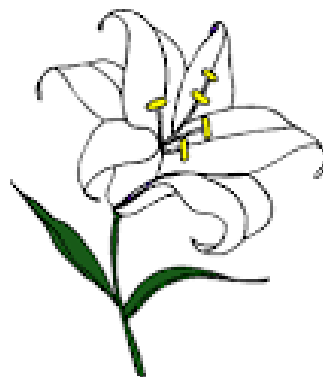


Our nursery could use a little refresh!
