A Message from Tyler:

The beauty of Maundy Thursday is that it celebrates Jesus starting the rite of communion that we now

celebrate regularly. Jesus knows that he will be betrayed and that the crucifixion is about to happen, yet he chooses to share and commemorate a meal with his disciples. In so doing, we now feast with the saints who have shared this meal for thousands of years.

Tomorrow, we will hear the message of Jesus washing the feet of his disciples from the Gospel of John. Scholars point out that the reason that it is such a profound thing is that Jesus was lowering himself to work that was meant for slaves. Jesus, the king and son of God, lowers himself for his disciples. It is his way of showing them how they should care for God's children.

We will end the service of Maundy Thursday with stripping the table in reverence for Jesus's abandonment in Gethsemane. The purple paraments of Easter will be removed, so that we may enter the sanctuary on Sunday to hear the miracle that Christ has risen. **Alleluia!** We have endured 40 days with Christ in the wilderness. Now we rejoice in the Easter resurrection and the eternal life that we are assured through the grace of God.

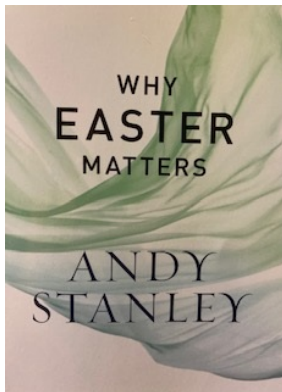
A Youth Update:

A Core 13 Update:



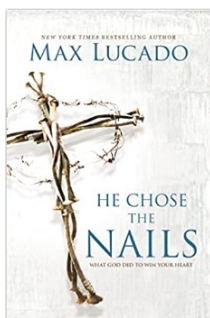
Core 13 is currently studying "Why Easter Matters" by Andy Stanley.

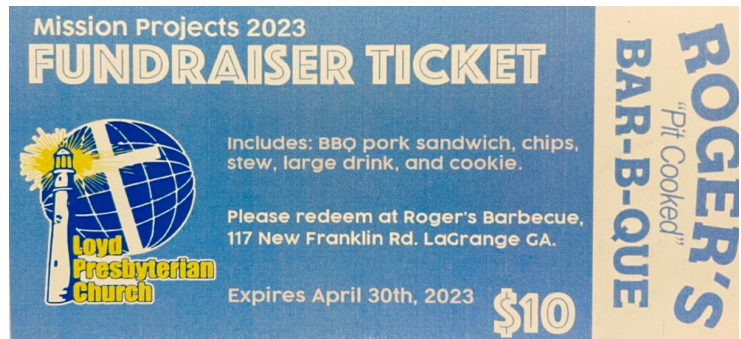
