A Message from Tyler:

Our gospel passage on Sunday depicts Jesus telling the disciples that if they love him, then they will keep his commandments. That message is presumably meant for any others gathered to listen to him, as well as the readers who are hearing his words two thousands years later.

Peter's letter instructs the early church to respond to hostile situations toward the faithful in a gentle and respectful manner. He implores them to maintain a good conscience and if they must, suffer for doing good instead of returning evil for evil. This message might resonate with readers of the modern era, as well.

In the face of challenges and criticisms of the greater church body, we defy hostility by reflecting the love for Jesus to others. We keep our faith in Christ and trust the Holy Spirit's guidance in all that we do. And when we find ourselves facing hostility to the church or our beliefs, we might respond in peace to that individual. Peter argues that "Christ also suffered for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, in order to bring you to God." We are led to be kind, welcoming, and open to all the forgiven children of God, perhaps offering a path toward bringing all a little closer toward community. Let us build up our spiritual house rather than be torn down by outside interferences.

Loyd Senior Day is Sunday, May 21st


Please plan to join us as we celebrate the graduating seniors in our congregation.




Core 13 is currently studying "Guardrails" by Andy Stanley.
