A Message from Tyler:

The day of Pentecost occurs on a Jewish festival day. The Jewish people were gathered at Jerusalem to celebrate Shavuot, "the Festival of Weeks," which occurs seven weeks after Passover. This day has both deep roots in the Jewish tradition and the Christian tradition. That follows because Christianity arose out of Judaism.

Pentecost is the day that many refer to as the birthday of the church. The coming of the Holy Spirit to the eleven is the beginning of the apostolic movement where they begin their mission outside of Jerusalem. It is a speaking of every tongue, symbolic that the Christian movement would not just be in Hebrew and only for the Jewish people, but all the people of the world. It is also sometimes seen as a bookend to the Tower of Babel narrative, where the people were scattered and the language of the people was confused. While the singularity of the people was broken at the Tower of Babel, Pentecost is the binding together of all the people.

There is much to celebrate on Sunday. And that is why we pray, "Come, Holy Spirit, come!"


Core 13 is currently studying "Guardrails" by Andy Stanley.
