#### A Message from Tyler:

On Sunday, we will be discussing the first time that Jesus sends the disciples out in their apostolic duties. Matthew has a few metaphors that he relies upon throughout his gospel. One of those metaphors is the concept of the harvest, which he often uses as a reference for the last judgment of God. This passage is an exception to the rule. The crowds represent a plentiful harvest, or rather a group of evangelized people who are a part of the future ministry of the church.

There is a great deal to this story, which we will talk about on Sunday morning, but the most important piece in my mind are the last words from Jesus in the passage: "You received without payment, give without payment." This statement is an exceptional metaphor for the grace that we receive from God. We are to pass along God's grace to others, because we have freely received it. May these words resonate with all of the work that we do in the world.






Core 13 is currently studying "Guardrails" by Andy Stanley.
