A Brief Word from Tyler:

This last two weeks, I have been engaged in conversation through conferences at the Presbytery and at Montreat regarding worship that has been fulfilling and enlightening. I'm going to try to write a narrative line that draws on all of the days of learning.

In the theater tradition of old, there were a few different roles. There was an audience who watched the play, an actor(s) who performed on stage, and a prompter--an individual who stood slightly off-stage to give lines to the actors if they forgot. Now, conventional wisdom would state that if we compared this theater model to worship, the congregation is the audience, the preacher is the actor, and the Holy Spirit is the prompter.

Theologian Soren Kierkegaard stated that his model of worship believes that the prompter is the preacher, the actor(s) is the congregation, and the audience of it all is God. Mike spoke about this idea to the children on Sunday (10/22/23).

It is a helpful reminder of why we worship. We are practicing skills of the faith in God's witness, and we are hopeful that we will take those practiced skills out to the world. We practice peace-making and community building when we pass the peace. We practice generosity when we give to the offering. We practice confession when we pray to God corporately and silently about our sins. Every element of worship strengthens the routine of how we live faithfully in the world.

Rev. Carlton Johnson said, "it is easier to worship Jesus than to follow and act like Jesus." His words still are ringing in my ears. Through our worship of Jesus, we practice living more like Jesus. When we faithfully live and follow Jesus, we build the kingdom of God here on earth as God witnesses.

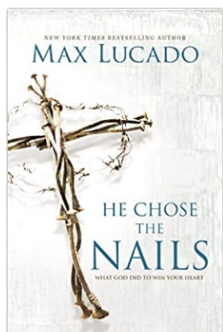

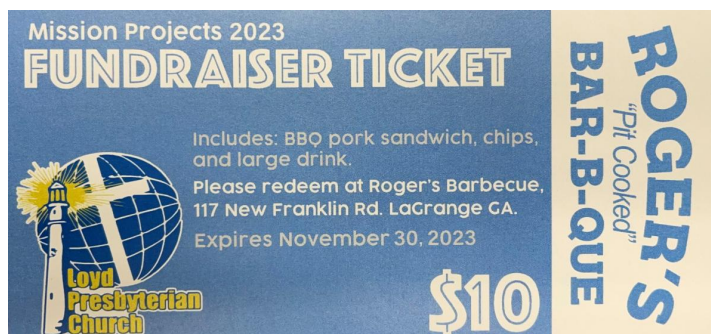
