#### A Brief Message from Tyler:

#### The Growing Church

The stories that we have been hearing post-Easter Sunday have been concerned with the burgeoning Christ movement within Judaism. One piece of history that eludes us is when exactly the Jewish faithful split off and became what we now call Christians. This past Sunday, the scripture from Acts illuminated a speech from Peter where he addressed the crowd as "Fellow Israelites." The book of Acts begins the story of the new church following Easter. It begins telling of Peter's work but switches halfway through and narrates Paul's journey. The rest of the New Testament (the letters ascribed to Paul, Peter, John, and others) are written to churches that have formed, so we have an idea of the beginnings of the Christian movement from these sources. What we don't know is exactly when and how it happened.

The lectionary is drawing upon the history that we know of the expanding church and the evangelism of nations beyond the Israelites. It is a post-resurrection narrative that is being taught and remains relevant post-Easter thousands of years later. Our first passage on Sunday is Peter's court appearance in Acts and his defense of his actions that got him arrested. The second is a continuation of First John in which the author illuminates a method of sharing the Gospel and living in Christ.

These stories provide a foundation for what the early church did to share Christ's message and grow the new church. They are especially important today. While we lack certain historical pieces, we are supported by the teachers of faith who impart their wisdom about the anchor of our faith and the way that we move in the world. For that, we give our thanks and praise to God.




Core 13 is currently studying The Handwriting on the Wall by Dr. David Jeremiah.



# Would you spend two hours to save a life?

Suicide continues to be a dilemma for our community with Georgia ranking 12th in the nation for death by suicide. Since COVID19, rates have increased, with some areas seeing triple the amount of suicides compared to this time last year. The QPR Institute offers an evidence- based suicide prevention course that strives to educate the public in order to help save lives. The primary objectives are to train participants to understand the nature and range of suicidal communications and how to intervene on behalf of suicidal and in-crisis people.
